



## **New Board Members for North Houston District**

*Hyatt Regency Intercontinental GM and Aldine ISD assistant superintendent appointed*

HOUSTON, TX - July 23, 2018 - On June 28, the North Houston District Board of Directors appointed two new board members, Tom Jamison, general manager of the Hyatt Regency Hotel Intercontinental and Abel Garza, assistant superintendent for the Aldine Independent School District.

The North Houston District (formerly known as the Greenspoint District), which oversees improvement projects for the Greens Crossing, Greenspoint, Pinto Business Park and Airline areas, has 18 board member positions. Five of these positions were vacant, with Jamison and Garza filling two of them.

“Tom is an ideal fit for our board,” says Greg Simpson, president of the North Houston District.

“Considering the high presence of the hospitality industry in the district, it’s critical to have hotel representation on our board. Tom is enthusiastic about the potential in the area, and that is the type of leadership and support needed.”

Jamison, has managed the Hyatt Regency Intercontinental since 2015, and been with the company since 1999.

Garza, who oversees community and governmental relations for Aldine ISD, replaces Archie Blanson, former deputy superintendent, who retired in the spring and served on the North Houston District board for a year.

“Abel has served on our marketing and public affairs committee for two years providing guidance and expertise on key issues and projects,” says Simpson. “His input is critical given the footprint Aldine ISD has in our area.”
